Our GPs wish to devote as much time as possible to providing their patients with NHS services. However we know there are times when you may require services which are not covered within the NHS contract we provide and we wish to make the process for applying for these services as straight forward as possible for you.

This leaflet contains information about the signing of certificates, application forms and provision of reports that are not part of the NHS service provision.

GPs have a statutory obligation to provide some certificates as part of their NHS Contract e.g.

- Notification of infectious diseases
- Statutory sick notes for illnesses lasting more than 7 days

GPs cannot give opinions on matters which they do not have specialist knowledge. e.g.

- If a child is fit to wear a school uniform
- If a child is fit to take part in a variety of social activities
- If a person is suitable to be a teacher
- Type of domestic heating required
- If a person is literate

If you require the completion of a certificate or form and you think the GP might be able to provide this you should still consider whether they are someone who has relevant knowledge about you and your circumstances and whether they can provide the information required.

Why do we make a charge?

Fees for private certificates and reports cover the cost of the time taken by a GP to review your full medical record and for the responsibility they accept when providing their signature. Your record is checked to ensure that it is accurate and to exclude any information which could compromise the confidentiality of a 3rd party.

The prices in this leaflet were correct at the time of printing, however costs may vary and you will need to enquire before a price can be confirmed.

Please note, not all of our GPs provide all of the services for a variety of reasons so please enquire with staff before assuming the service can be provided.

A selection of services that we may be able to provide to you are below. Some prices include VAT and some do not due to our partial exemption VAT registration. This list is not exhaustive and if the service you require isn't listed on here please ask at reception and where a price states POA please enquire at reception:
